## Patrick & Judith Ann Kennedy Inducted Into The Indiana Horseman's Hall of Fame

The following was read during the presentation:

It is common in the equine world to have husband and wife teams. These teams may be in the training, exhibiting, breeding, or other areas. Some of those teams that readily come to mind are Tom and Donna, Larry and Barb, and Karen and Ed. One more that can be added to the list are Jay and Pat - Kennedy that is. Jay isn't her given name, but rather one that she was given in her early years. But how many of you would know Judith Ann Kennedy. Although neither are Indiana natives, they have been an integral part of the Indiana equine scene for the past 25 plus years.

This couple started their equine careers in two different breeds and nearly fifteen hundred miles apart. The Morgan breed was Jay's first love when she was a child in the Northeast. Pat grew up on the family farm in Taylorville, Illinois. Kennedy Pony Farm was a premier Hackney breeding and exhibiting farm. They have maintained the Kennedy tradition of breeding quality Hackney ponies. The Kenhurst prefix is prominent in the show ring and in breeding herds. The most famous of the group include Kenhurst Ballet, Kenhurst Kilimanjaro, Kenhurst Constantinople, Kenhurst Dixie Duke and the list continues.

Jay and Pat are both very active within equine organizations. Seldom will you see them serving on the same committee, thus allowing them to assist more organizations. Pat has served as President and Board of Director for the Hoosier Hackney Association. He is currently serving on the American Hackney Horse Society Board of Directors. He is a USEF licensed Judge. Pat is an Internationally recognized harness maker. Kennedy Harness Company harness has been worn by a multitude of champions, both in the United States and throughout the world. The Kennedy's were instrumental in establishing the Hoosier Hackney Association twenty five years ago. Jay devotes a majority of her time to the Hoosier Hackney Association and the American Hackney Horse Society functions. She is HHA Futurity Secretary and Serves on the Board of Directors. She is the President of the AHHS Foundation, and that provides her great satisfaction in seeing the progress the foundation has made to promote the Hackney pony. She is Chairman of the AHHSF Adult Driving Challenge, one of the most popular programs that contributes to the promotion of the Hackney. Jay, as President of the AHHS Foundation was instrumental in spearheading the AHHS Foundation promotional DVD that debuted to accolades at the 2010 AHHS annual meeting. I am sure if you ask her she would provide you with a copy for your viewing. For the past two years Jay has chaired, organized, cooked and served breakfast for the Hackney exhibitors at the Ohio State Fair. What better equine promotion can you find than free food. The Kennedys can be found providing demonstrations to numerous 4-H organizations in the Central Indiana area or working the various horse fairs. If it needs done, Jay and Pat are there to "do it".

Pat and Jay exemplify the criteria for the Indiana Horseman's Hall of Fame, continuing dedication and outstanding contributions in promotion, education, welfare, and development of the Indiana equine industry.

Early Edition, a high stepping Hackney Pony, took part in a driving demonstration at the Equine Village at the 2010 Alltech FEI World Equestrian Games, much to the delight of the crowd who gathered around to find out more about the glamorous, eye-catching Hackney. Early Edition, owned by T.J. and Georgia Blevins of Blevins Farm in Bowling Green, Kentucky, is an American and Canadian National Champion Hackney Pleasure Pony.

Blevins said she was thrilled to be asked to perform a demonstration with Early Edition at the World Equestrian Games and was pleased that so many people were introduced to the breed. ## 2010 Hackney Hall of Fame Karen Waldron

Thirty years ago the Hackney industry was blessed when a well-established Saddlebred family was introduced to the world of ponies. The Waldron family's Bent Tree Farm, Shawsville, VA was home to some of the best American Saddlebreds in the country with daughter Karen winning numerous world's championships under their Hall of Fame trainers. When the matriarch of the family, Evelyn, decided she wanted to start showing, her husband Elbert suggested they go to Lexington Junior League and see what was out there. There she saw the harness pony Wildfire and fell in love. When she first sat behind him, showing ponies became Evelyn's love. In 1982 she and Wildfire captured the Amateur Harness Pony World's Championship.

Tijauna Princess was purchased as a Christmas present for Karen's dad. "This was all about my parents, but then I stepped in and started showing them as well. Their passion turned in to mine," said Karen. In 1983 Tijauna Princess won the World's Grand Championship, the Reserve World's Grand Championship in 1984, and in 1985. Ben Lester showed her to the Amateur World's Champion of Champions title.

In 1990, Karen purchased Vindicator from the Ed Wilson family and he became the foundation for the Bent Tree breeding program. Soon, Night Editor, My Sweet Georgia Brown, and Julianna also joined the Waldron family under the direction of home trainer Lee Adams.

At Louisville 1997, Karen saw Heartland Ooh! La La. "She took my breath away," stated Karen. "I did something I have never done before; I stood at the gate and grabbed Darrel Kolkman as he came out of the three-year-old class and told him I had to decide whether to go back in the junior stake or the big stake." She was the 1997 World's Grand Champion.

While at the Devon Horse Show in 2000, Karen purchased her first Hackney Horse, Heartland Blizzard who was three at the time. She showed her immediately and won the Devon Championship. That fall they did an embryo transfer and the resulting foal was Shelburne, who like her dam, has won multiple World Championships.

Bent Tree's relationship with trainer, Larry Ella, began with the purchase of Spirit Of Success. At that time they saw Par Excellence and asked for first refusal. Karen Waldron and Shawn Ricci were married in Toronto on August 5, 2000. The next day on the way to their honeymoon destination they purchased Par Excellence. The next year he and Karen won the World's Champion Of Champions Junior Harness Pony title. In 2003, the Reserve World's Grand Champion and the World's Grand Champion in 2004 with Waldron, followed by two more reserve world's titles in the following two years. Sweetheart Of Success was purchased in 2005 and she too won a World's Grand Championship. In 2007, Vindicator, returned to the ring looking like a youngster. Karen and the regal stallion paraded around Freedom Hall to great applause on their way to the Amateur Harness Pony World's Champion of Champions title. The next year Karen drove On The Mark to the World's Grand Championship.

"There is nothing I love more than riding a good five-gaited horse but the kinetic energy of sitting behind a really game, brilliant Hackney pony makes you use your brain, unlike a horse where the energy is in your hands, your seat, your legs, : explained Karen. "With a pony all the energy is in your fingers. I remember the first time I drove Ooh! La La. She rolled her neck so far back and her whole body was electrifying. The electricity ran from her body through my fingers. I was laughing and crying at the same time; it was so thrilling. If you're sitting behind something looking through their ears, you know when they're on fire." *(Contents courtesy of Bent Tree Farm)*
