III. Approval of Meeting Minutes: July 6, 2009 Meeting. Approved with correction of deleting last part of last sentence of the registry review. Motion made by Vern Houston and second by Dr. Bing Crosby. Motion carried.

IV. Executive Committee: Judith Lowry, Chair. Reported that they are working on things in the office and the upcoming convention.

V. President's Report: Judith Lowry, President.

VI. Office Report: Mickey Hernandez
Office: Publishing software was upgraded from Pagemaker 7.0 to InDesign CS4 without any complications.

We are still informing the Kentucky Horse Park staff of repairs that have not been completed. Mailed checks for AHHS National Breeders' Futurity and Sweepstakes winners. With the limited amount of office space some documents dated before the year 2000 will be sent to a shredding company.

Website: Keeping up with all updates on a weekly basis. The time has come for a major upgrade to make changes more efficient in the office. Casey Haley will discuss this in his presentation.

Christy Gantley - As of Sept. 9, 2009, the Society recorded 583 individual, 207 family, 65 youth, and 125 life members. There are 453 hackneys registered with AHHS of which 29 are hackney horses. Transfers to date are 363.

On July 29, the Kentucky Horse Park hosted Media Day. This day is set aside for all the breed organizations to have a few minutes in the spotlight and grab the attention of the media, so they will want to learn more about your horses and hopefully be intrigued enough to come back and cover a show or possibly do some human/horse stories. This year, the AHHS was represented. I volunteered to bring a World Champion Hackney Pony. I enjoyed the experience, but now after participating, I have a few suggestions for next year. We were stabled in the big barn which is far away from media. I suggest we be stabled closer to the arena so the media will visit the stall area.

The website is still being updated on a regular basis and the Google Analytics still shows that our site is working for us. Also, I would like to commend Jay Kolkman for his continuous efforts on making the AHHSF video some thing special that relates to all. I wish him much success. I would also like to thank Mickey Hernandez for fulfilling my duties while I took off the month of August.

Horse Illustrated also had a Hackney on it's front cover in July. That pony was Dun Haven Phenomenal when they visited Majestic Oaks.

VIII. Foundation Committee Report: Sandra Surber, Chair. The scheduled meeting was cancelled for lack of a quorum.

IX. Committee Reports and Discussion

Web Site/Internet: David Estis, Chair.
- Updates are being done to the website every week. The time has come to update the software for the website since the Macromedia Contribute will eventually be outdated and has caused problems when changing files or loading pictures. There is also the question of the online registry being updated from the office instead sending files to a company in California. This would eliminate the middle man and be more cost efficient in the long run. Casey Haley will give a presentation later.

- Gib Marcucci was inducted into the Hall of Fame Monday night of the Kentucky State Fair. A reception was held later that evening in the aisle way of Gib Marcucci Stables after the last class. The catering bill was sent to the AHHSF office to be paid.

Audit Committee: Vern Houston, No Report.

By-Laws: Randy Harper, Chair. - By-Law change request was passed at July meeting. Article V. Section 7.

Former wording: The Board of Directors of the American Hackney Horse Society shall meet quarterly, if feasible, and in any case, at least three (3) times annually. The Secretary/Executive Secretary shall give at least fifteen (15) days notice in writing of any meeting of the Board of Directors, stating the time, place and purpose of the meeting. Meetings may be held within or without the State of New York.

New change: The Board of Directors of the American Hackney Horse Soci-

ety shall hold quarterly meetings, if feasible, in any case, at least three (3) times annually. The Secretary/Executive Secretary shall give notice, either by mail, phone or electronically, at least five (5) days in advance of any meeting of the Board of Directors, stating time, place (either physical location or by conference call, see Article V Section 3) and purpose of the meeting. Meetings may be held within or without the State of New York.

Purpose of change: From the fact that conference calls are allowed under Article V, Section 3 the fifteen (15) day rule is excessive. Fifteen days was implied to accommodate travel plans.

Rule change that was tabled from July meeting was again tabled. Rules And Regulation Change Request Section 6., Rule 2.

Present wording: If conviction results from the drug testing program, both the trainer and owner shall have their membership suspended for one (1) year and shall forfeit all prize money, trophies and ribbons received in the class in which the offense occurred. This will apply to owners whether or not they are aware of the use of drugs by the trainer. Neither the trainer nor the owner or the animal involved shall be eligible to show in any class sponsored by the Society during the next calendar year. These penalties will automatically be imposed upon receipt of official notice of positive tests, with no vote of the Board of Directors being desired or necessary to implement penalties.

Recommended change: The American Hackney Horse Society will defer to the United States Equestrian Federation (USEF) in regards to any penalties placed on members of the American Hackney Horse Society. Period of suspended membership of the American Hackney Horse Society will concur with penalty time imposed by the USEF. If conviction occurs in a class sponsored by the American Hackney Horse Society (i.e. Futurity, Limited Breeders Stake etc.) all prize money, trophies and ribbons received in that class will be returned to the American Hackney Horse Society. These penalties will automatically be imposed upon official notice from the USEF, with no vote of the Board of Directors being desired or necessary to implement penalties.

Purpose of change: To bring rule

within the practice of the Board of Directors. AHHS will follow any penalties imposed by USEF to members of the society.

Convention: Judith E. Lowry, Co-Chair. It was asked if our Thursday night dinner could be incorporated with the Friday afternoon luncheon. We had no problem with this and it will be discussed at the next convention meeting.

Corporate Sponsors/Associate Members: No Chair.

Driving/Open Competition: Sandra Surber, Chair. To date we have 12 Hackneys (5 are horses) entered in the Open Competition program ranging from In-Hand, carriage, hunter/jumper, dressage and eventing. Working on a point system so Open competition will be eligible for Champion status.

National Hackney Horse Futurity/Promotional Committee: Matthew Schuckert, Chair. - Hackney Horse Futurity will be held at the National Show Horse Finals in Springfield, IL. Judge will be Tim Lockard from Russell, Iowa. To date there are seven horses entered in all but one class (Pleasure driving). Both the trophies and ribbons have been sent to the National Show Horse Registry office. A big thank you to Darrel and Sandy Kolkman, Ed and Ronet Murray, Luc Boileau and Tom Rogers for making the effort to keep Hackney horses in the AHHS Futurity. The committee will have to look for another show that will hold the horse futurity. A suggestion from the July meeting was to keep only the weanling and harness horse class.

Halstead Viking was featured in Audrey Pavia's book "Horse Lover's Daily Companion."

AHHS National Breeders Futurity & Sweepstakes: Matthew Schuckert, Chair. The Judge for this years AHHS Futurity & Sweepstakes was Kent Swalla from Missouri. This year we had a total of 48 ponies showing in the Futurity and Sweepstakes. There was only one class where the ribbons had to be redistributed due to the pony never being nominated as a weanling. Questionnaires will be put on a spread sheet for a future meeting.

The breakfast and lunch in the hospitality room were very popular not only with the Hackney exhibitors but also from the other breeds. Thank you to Dr. Bing Crosby, Pat & Jay Kennedy, Bruce Ekstrom, Charles McCallister, Alicia Schuckert, Barb & Chuck Fitzpatrick and to anyone else who volunteered. Thank you also to Kenhurst

Stables for donating the refreshments during the afternoon session. We fed close to 800 people and the budget came in over the allotted funds (\$500) but the Executive Committee agreed to pay the bill.

Fund-Raising Auction/Raffle: Maureen Lydon, Chair. -We have received more items for the silent auction. Still working on another fund-raiser/raffle idea to replace the reverse raffle for the Freedman Harness. Suggestions of a weanling show halter and a yearling show bridle were made with the raffle tickets being sold for \$25. This is being considered.

Limited Breeders' Weanling & 3-Year-Old Stakes and 2010 Auction: Chris Gantley, Chair.

2009 LBS Weanlings Stake - Contract for drug testing has been signed with USEF. The halters and coolers for championship and another for the reserve pony champion have been ordered. The same for payouts will remain as last year; no money will be awarded until both the Drug & DNA Testing are complete. We had a good class last night with quality from top to bottom, we just need more entries.

2010 & 2011 Three-Year Old Driving - See list of eligible 3-Year Old LBS Hackneys on page 12.

2010 Auction - The Limited Breeders Stakes Rules and Regulations as well as contracts are available ONLINE and will be in next newsletter. Stallion Donors will be offered Free Advertisement of their stallions on the website, but should get their pictures sent to the office as quickly as possible.

As stated in the last report the auction will be held in February in Shelbyville, Kentucky at the Old Stone Inn. The evening will begin with a General Informational Membership Meeting (formerly held during the KY State Fair) and Cocktails at 3:30 P.M. with Dinner to be served at 4:30 P.M. and the Auction will start at 5:30 P.M. There has even been a suggestion to invite Jim Aikman.

Membership/Membership Directory: Scott Seils, Chair. We need to know if this directory is a go or not.

A motion was made to go with the directory and use the plain cover similar to the stud book. Motion made by Darrel Kolkman and second by Vern Houston. Motion carried. The book must be ready for the printer by March 31, 2010. It was also suggested that we auction the inside front, inside back, and back cover.

Nominating: Sandra J. Surber, Chair.

Report. - I have a completed list of ten names to be submitted as nominees for the AHHS Board of Directors.

Regional Associations: Patrick Kennedy, Chair. Report. - The National Academy Championship Finals wishes to extend an open invitation to members of the AHHS. Dates are Oct 31-Nov.1, 2009 at the Miller Coliseum in Murfreesboro, TN. This is the 10 year anniversary of this exciting one of a kind show for the Academy Riders and Drivers. Fourteen states were represented last year, and this show continues to grow every year. The show committee believes the Grass Roots are the future of our industry. They have added an Academy Road Pony class to encourage more kids and adults to get into driving. A Pleasure Driving pony class has been very successful in the past and we encourage more participation from the members of the AHHS to support this show. Sponsorship Policy: The American Hackney Horse Society will adopt a policy in regard to granting sponsorships pertaining but not limited to classes, trophies or any involvement of a horse show or competition open to Hackneys. With the exception of the World Champion Horse Show held in Louisville, KY, the following procedures and requirements will be followed before any AHHS funds will be given. Should a competition (e.g. Carriage Competition) that is also open to Hackneys the same procedures shall be followed:

1. A letter requesting sponsorship from the horse show chairperson, member of the horse show board, or committee member. The letter must contain dates of show, the location of horse show, listing of Hackney classes (or classes open to Hackneys) that are to be sponsored and the amount the horse show would like to receive.

2.The horse show must be able to provide a prize list or premium book of listed Hackney classes or classes open to Hackneys as well as prizes (ribbons, trophies and money) that are to be paid in each class. The prize list or premium should also the names of the officials (manager, secretary, judges, etc.).

3. All horse shows that are sanctioned by United States Equestrian Federation must be in good standing. All other shows that are not sanctioned by USEF but have been reported for unethical business

practices or criminal and/or civil charges that have been made against any members of the horse show board or staff related to the horse show shall be refused sponsorship.

4. The final decision of granting sponsorships is to come from the AHHS Executive Committee. After each request for sponsorship has been reviewed and a unanimous or majority decision has been made.

Once all the requirements have been met the request will be submitted to the AHHS Treasurer for final approval and a check will be granted in the requested amount to the horse show.

UPHA Liaison: Randy Harper, Chair. - The 2011 UPHA Convention IS STILL taking place in Boston, Massachusetts.

Youth Medallion: Kathy Barlow, Co-chair. No Report.
